Halloween Parade: The Elementary Halloween Parade will be held on Thursday, October 26th at 10:00 AM (weather permitting). When students arrive at school, they should already be dressed in their costumes. As you prepare costumes for the students to wear to school, you will want to remember the following:

1. The top priority is the safety of all students.
2. Students must be able to walk in their costume.
3. Be sure students have a clear vision through any type of mask or costume.
4. All items of the costume must follow school rules. Please keep in mind the following:
 - a. students should not have any type of weapons (real or toys); this includes guns, knives, swords, bows, etc.,

- b. no type of wheels, this includes bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, scooters, etc.
5. Costumes must comply with the school dress codes. Students must wear appropriate clothing on the school day. Students should not wear tops with thin straps, a student's mid-section should not be showing, and the length of shorts and skirts should be an appropriate length. If you have any questions concerning appropriate attire please refer to page 32 of the Student-Parent Handbook.
6. Check the weather forecast for the day of the parade to insure your child is dressed for the weather conditions.
7. The school's goal is student safety.

If a student's costume does not comply with these guidelines, modifications to the costume will be made that will still allow the student to walk in the parade. We want all students to be able to participate in the parade. Thank you for your understanding and compliance with these guidelines.
