Attending Evening Activities

- During evening activities (such as basketball games, volleyball games, etc.), outside food and drinks should not be brought into the school building. Anyone bringing items into the building will be asked to dispose of them properly.
- When attending a game, individuals will not be allowed to walk under the bleachers to move from one side of the gym to the other. Each of these issues are for the safety of those attending the event.
- Fans are also asked to refrain from entering or exiting the gym while play is in progress. This will eliminate movement that could disrupt the basketball game while it is in progress. Fans are asked to only enter and exit the gym during a time out, during half time, and between quarters.
- The use of tobacco products is prohibited on school property. This includes the use of chewing tobacco in the building.

School will be dismissed at 2:19 PM on Wednesday, November 22nd. There will be no school on Thursday, November 23rd and Friday, November 24th due to the Thanksgiving holiday. School will resume on Monday, November 27, 2017.

PTO News:

The PTO will be sponsoring Santa's Cottage on Thursday, November 30th (all day) and Friday, December 1st (AM only). Santa's Cottage allows students to purchase small gifts to give to family members. Students in grades K – 5 will be given a time during the school day to shop at Santa's Cottage. More information will be sent home at a later time.

High School Academic Eligibility Requirements: A student participating in any team sport or extracurricular (non-graded) activity must be passing all courses. Grade checks will take place on Friday, every week. If a student is determined ineligible, he or she must remain ineligible for at least one week before grades are re-evaluated. Any work submitted to a teacher after 3:30 PM on Thursday prior to the grade check shall not be considered until the next eligibility check. For purposes of eligibility, an incomplete shall become a failing grade if not removed by the next grade check, unless there are extenuating circumstances as determined by the administration. In addition, a student must pass all courses at the end of each semester in order to be academically eligible for participation throughout the ensuing semester.

Junior High School Academic Eligibility Requirements:

Students must satisfy all academic standards and must comply with the activity's rules and the student conduct code. In order to participate in any extracurricular and/or co-curricular activity, students are required to receive passing grades in all classes each grading quarter. If a student receives a failing grade on his or her report card, then the student will be unable to participate

in extracurricular and co-curricular activities during the next two grading periods. Once a student is participating in an extracurricular and/or co-curricular activity, he or she must continue to pass all courses that are used to determine a student's GPA. These eligibility checks will be performed each week of the season. If a student is determined ineligible, he or she must remain ineligible for at least one week before grades are re-evaluated.
